MONDAY

v.1 O LORD, our Lord, your majestic name fills the earth! Your glory is higher than the heavens.

- O LORD, I surrender this day to your lordship of my life
- Lord, keep me mindful each day of your majesty that fills the earth
- Reveal your glory to my unchurched friend and draw them to Jesus
- Let my life reflect your glory and inspire others around me

TUESDAY

v.2 You have taught children and infants to tell of your strength, silencing your enemies and all who oppose you.

- Let me have a childlike faith in your strength
- Continue to bless the Briarcliff Kids as they learn of your strength
- Thank you for the faithful leaders that teach in Briarcliff Kids
- Protect our children from the influence of the enemies in the world

WEDNESDAY

v.3-4 When I look at the night sky and see the work of your fingers— the moon and the stars you set in place—what are people that you should think about them, mere mortals that you should care for them?

- Help me to never lose the awe of your marvelous creation
- Keep me mindful that you are thinking of me all the time
- Capture the heart of my unchurched friend with the awe of your creation
- Never let me forget that I am physically mortal in this life but through Jesus we have immortality and a new body in heaven

THURSDAY

v.5 Yet you made them only a little lower than God and crowned them with glory and honor.

- Keep me mindful of my value that comes from you being my creator
- Guide me to wear the crown of your glory in a way that glorifies you
- Open the eyes of my unchurched friend to see their value and that eternity in heaven comes only from you, our creator
- Lead me to fulfill the reason you created me

FRIDAY

v.6-8 You gave them charge of everything you made, putting all things under their authority—the flocks and the herds and all the wild animals, the birds in the sky, the fish in the sea, and everything that swims the ocean currents.

- Guide me in being a good steward of what you have given me to manage
- Keep me mindful that everything belongs to you and I am only a manager for a short while
- Keep me mindful that I will stand in judgment and give an account of how I have managed the gifts you have given me
- Reveal to my unchurched friend that everything we have in this life is only temporary and only in Jesus we have anything in eternity

SATURDAY

v.9 O LORD, our Lord, your majestic name fills the earth!

- Keep me mindful throughout the day of your majestic name that fills the earth
- I want to continually surrender my life to you as my Lord (boss)
- Help me to worship your majesty every single day
- Captivate the heart of my unchurched friend with your majestic name and surrender their life to you as their Lord and savior
